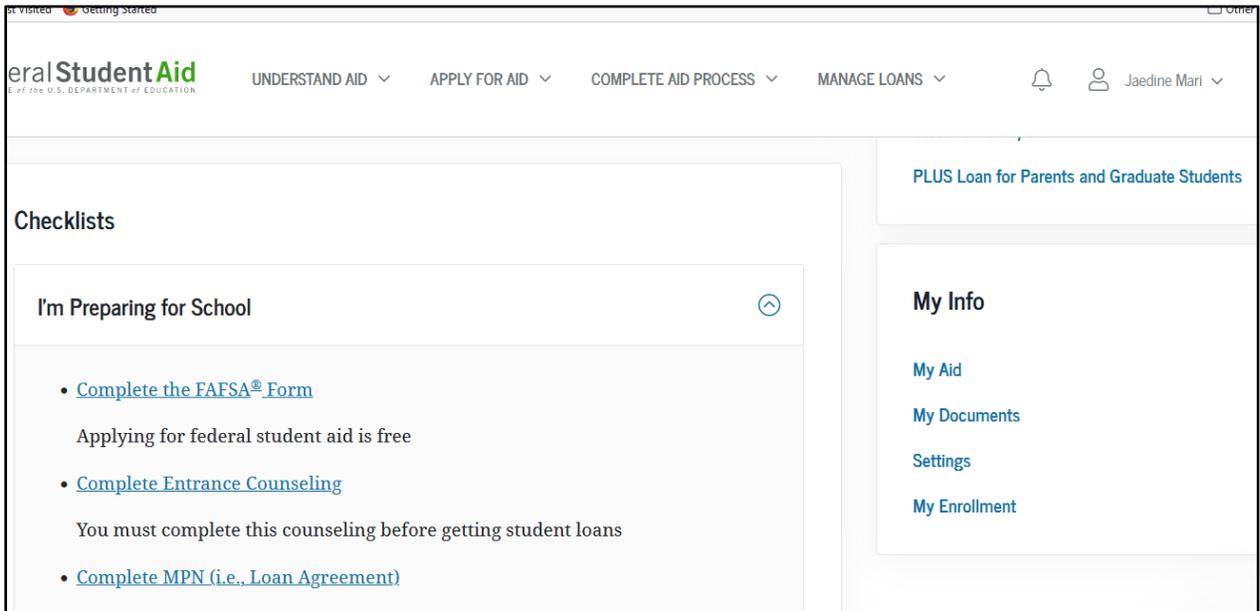
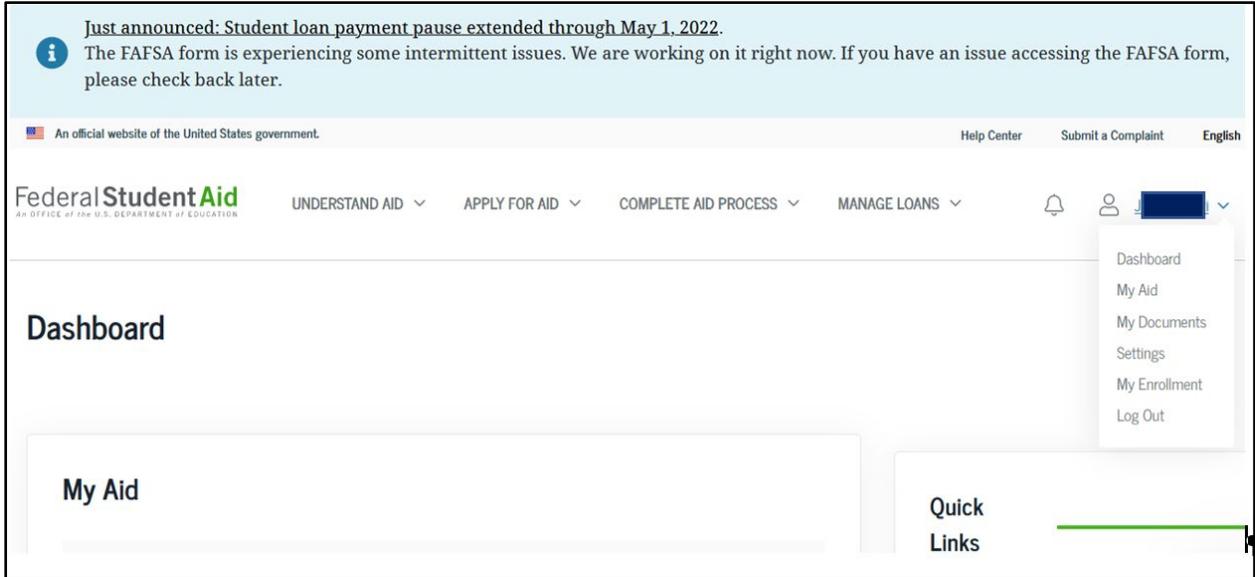


1. Log in
